

How to Embed Google Docs on your Page

Google Docs offers a free web-based solution for word processing and spreadsheet creation that allows you to create, edit and store your content online.

Add Google Docs to your Page

1. Head to your [Google Docs](#).
2. Navigate to the document or spreadsheet that you'd like to embed.
3. Copy embed code provided (under 'Publish to the Web') using the CMD+C (on Mac) or CTRL+C (on Windows) shortcut.
4. Head to the PageCloud page you would like the Google Doc to appear on.
5. Paste the embed code directly onto your page using CMD+V (on Mac) or CTRL+v (on Windows) Shortcut.
6. The Google Doc embed code may appear as an empty wireframe. Don't worry, when viewed live it will display gallery as expected.
7. Click "Save" to save your changes to the page.
8. Click "View Live" to see the Doc on your page.

Note: permissions for viewing or password protection needs to be done in the Google Docs / Google Sheets app. Use [this article](#) for a walkthrough.
